Will demo Adobe's just released program - **Lightroom**.

Katrin described Lightroom as a program designed for digital photographers and positioned halfway between PhotoShop Elements and the full version of Photoshop. Professional photographers and many serious amateurs shoot a lot of digital photos, I mean really a lot; after all electrons are free. With 35 mm film the cost was about a dollar every time you clicked the shutter and had prints made. Lightroom is designed to work quickly and easily with a large quantity of images. Not only can you quickly sort, file, tag, number, rank, and keyword hundreds of images, but you can do many Photoshop adjustments easier and in some cases better than in Photoshop CS2. Lightroom works readily with camera raw files. Crop photos, adjust levels, balance color and then apply these adjustments to groups of similar photos.

Katrin says she now starts with Lightroom and then moves to CS2 when she needs to work on the pixel level.
